HIGH SCHOOL / GPA RELEASE OPT-OUT

(Assembly bill 2160)

Consideration for a Cal Grant Entitlement award requires the submission of a high school GPA. Cal Grant awards can be used towards furthering education at most universities, community colleges and technical schools in California and **DO NOT** have to be paid back.

This new state mandate requires all high schools (public and charter) to upload GPAs to the California Student Aid Commission for all enrolled seniors.

(Section 9528 of the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001)
