

## **Alder Grove On-Campus Classes: Semester 1 2017-18**

### **Classes begin September 5, 2017**

#### **Registration:**

**Registration begins Friday, August 18, 2017. Registration forms will not be accepted before August 18th. #### **Tuesday/Thursday High School Students**

**If a high school student has a break between classes, you need to write where you expect them to be during that time based on the schedule. Students will not be permitted to “hang out” in the lobby or lunch area while classes are in session.** Math lab is available from 9:00-3:00 every day. There are open computer labs, writing labs and study halls at various times. Your student is expected to work quietly on schoolwork during any of these scheduled labs. If your student will be meeting with his or her CT, tutor, or other employee during that time, please indicate that on the schedule. Please look carefully at the schedule and talk to your student about where they need to go between classes.

**Students will NOT be registered for classes if this information is not provided.** For Tuesday/Thursday high school classes, both classes must be attended. These hybrid classes require approximately 3-5 hours of work outside of the on-campus class meetings.

#### **Monday/Wednesday/Friday Enrichment Classes**

In order for more students to participate in enrichment classes, please sign up for your top two Monday/Wednesday afternoon and Friday classes. List your other choices below the top two in order. We will do our best to make sure students get into their top two choices. Remember that enrollments are first-come, first-served beginning Friday August 18th, 2017. A waiting list will be started for students who register after a class has reached 12 students. If your child is on a waiting list you will be notified via the email you provide on the registration form. Students in grades K-8 will not be able to leave the campus for the lunch break.

**Remember that math lab is a time for students to get help with their math work. Students must bring math work to math lab. Students will not be allowed to sit in math lab and play math games on the computer.**

***Please pick up your child after their last scheduled class each day.***

**Fees: 1 Day per week classes or 1 Hour per week classes or a 2.5 credit class = \$75.00**

**2 Days per week classes or 2 Hours per week classes or a 5 credit class = \$150.00**

This amount is taken out of the student's budget per semester.

**Academic Support classes, Study Hall, and Math/Language Arts Labs are free of charge.**

#### **Dropping a class:**

Classes may be dropped at any time in the first two weeks after classes start. Any student who drops after this will be charged the full class price for the semester.

**Adding a class:** Any student adding a class after classes begin will need to communicate with their Credentialed Teacher in order to see if there is space. **Please do not add a class without approval.**
