3. If the IEP team determines that ALDER GROVE CHARTER SCHOOL is not the least restrictive environment for a student, then the student will return to his/her district of residence for appropriate placement.

5. Enrollment in the charter school program is an optional educational alternative that is voluntarily selected.

By signing this contract, I, the undersigned, agree that I have received the Charter, the Parent Handbook, and this Agreement, and understand the Charter school's philosophy, program, and requirements. As a parent, I accept FULL responsibility for my child's education. ALDER GROVE CHARTER SCHOOL is a Charter School that is structured to allow a new and different approach to the education of my child. This innovative approach may not be appropriate for all children. Should my child require personnel and services in addition to those provided by the ALDER GROVE CHARTER SCHOOL'S Personalized Learning Program, I understand that the staff of ALDER GROVE CHARTER SCHOOL will assist me in re-enrolling my child in our district of residence.
