

MINIMUM GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

The aspiration of the charter school, in partnership with the community, is to provide an exceptional education that prepares students to be successful members of our democratic society. Therefore, the graduation requirements stated below have been established. The graduation requirements encompass the knowledge, abilities, and experience necessary to develop the essential aptitudes and skills of successful participants in today's society: behavior of character, communication, citizenship, intellect, self-direction, teamwork, wellbeing and productivity.

Students are to be provided with assistance to tailor the requirements according to their individual needs and abilities. Students must demonstrate proficiency in reading comprehension, writing and mathematics. Those students not proficient will be provided with remedial programs after consultation with the student's parent/guardian and certified teacher.

In addition to the following graduation requirements, students must pass the High School Exit Exam and all other state and federal mandated assessments.

Additional requirements will be added if necessary when state Ed. Codes change.

English	40 credits
Math	20 credits including 10 units of algebra
Social Studies	30 credits including 10 of U.S. History, 10 of World History, 5 of Economics and 5 of Ci
Science	20 credits including 10 of a life science and 10 of a physical science
Foreign Language or Visual/Performing Arts	10 credits
Health	5 credits
Physical Education	20 credits
Technology	5 credits
Electives	70 credits
Total:	220 credits
