GPA / Military Release Form**

**HIGH SCHOOL / GPA RELEASE OPT-OUT**

(Assembly Bill 2160 (2014))

Consideration for a Cal Grant Entitlement award requires the submission of a high school GPA. Cal Grant awards can be used towards furthering education at most universities, community colleges and technical schools in California and **DO NOT** have to be paid back.

A state mandate requires all public high schools (traditional and charter) to upload GPAs to the California Student Aid Commission for all enrolled seniors.

MILITARY / RECRUITER OPT-OUT**

(Section 8528 of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act)

The Every Student Succeeds Act requires schools to release a student's private information to military recruiters unless the parent/guardian "opts out" in writing. Please note, parental "opt-out" only lasts until a student's 18<sup>th</sup> birthday. At that time, the student him- or herself must submit the "opt-out" form.
