**Objective:** The student will complete the courses appropriate for the grade level listed above. All course objectives will be consistent with the established policies of Alder Grove Charter School-2 and Common Core State Standards. Learning Records will be completed by the CT at scheduled intervals and will include specific descriptions of the major course concepts/objectives, the course of study activities covered by this agreement, and the "Course Value," or number of weeks of work, assigned for each course. It is understood that:

This agreement is to enable the student to successfully reach the objectives and complete the concepts which will be delineated in the Learning Record.

1. Method of Study: Specific methods of study will be designated by the assignments from the teacher and the Attendance Record. Examples of methods of study for the student will include but are not limited to: Independent Reading, Textbook Activities, Problem Solving, Study Projects, Drill & Practice, Experiential Learning, Computerized Curriculum, Web/Internet Research, Library Research, Field Trips, Learning Center Courses, other \_\_\_\_\_.

2. Method of Evaluation: Academic Evaluation will be designated in assignments from the teacher and the Attendance Record. Examples of acceptable methods of evaluation include but are not limited to: Teacher-made Tests, Student Conferences, Progress/Report Cards, Chapter/Unit Tests, Work Samples, Observations, Portfolios, State Standards Testing, Learning Journals, Presentations, Quizzes, Labs, Finals, other \_\_\_\_\_.

3. If a student misses two (2) assignments during any period of twenty (20) school days, an Intervention is conducted to determine whether it is in the best interests of the pupil to remain in independent study. Therefore, when any pupil fails to complete two (2) assignments during any period of twenty (20) school days, the Director or his or her designee shall conduct an intervention to determine whether it is in the best interests of the pupil to remain in independent study. A written record of the findings of any Intervention conducted pursuant to this policy shall be treated as a mandatory interim pupil record. This record shall be maintained for a period of three years from the date of the Intervention and if the pupil transfers to another California public school, the record shall be forwarded to that school.

4. Alder Grove Charter School-2 will provide the parent and student: teacher services, instructional materials, and other necessary items and resources as required to meet the Standards for the current grade level.

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
