

# Alder Grove On-Campus Parent Agreement

Please read, initial, and sign below.

This form must be returned with registration form(s) for on-campus classes.

\_\_\_\_\_ Classes are filled on a first-come, first-serve basis. We will do our best to make sure that students get into their top two choices. Schedules and wait list information will be emailed to parents via the email provided on the registration form.

\_\_\_\_\_ Students should not be dropped off more than 10 minutes before their first class starts and should be picked up no later than 10 minutes after their last class. Students are expected to arrive on time.

\_\_\_\_\_ Space is limited in our building. Please reserve cubbies, study hall areas, and lunch areas for teacher meetings and students only.

\_\_\_\_\_ Students in grades K-8 will not be able to leave campus for the lunch break or breaks between classes.

\_\_\_\_\_ For 2-day-a-week middle school and high school classes, both classes must be attended. These classes also require approximately 3-5 hours of homework outside of meeting times. If you feel that more than 2 classes per semester might be missed, or that there might be difficulty getting homework done, please consider not signing up for these classes.

\_\_\_\_\_ Math Lab is intended for students who need help with math work. Students must bring math work or have scheduled Let's Go Learn time. We recommend Math Lab for 4th-12th grade students only. Math Lab is Monday-Friday, 9:00-3:00.

\_\_\_\_\_ Students who have breaks between classes or meetings should be in designated labs or Study Hall only. No student is allowed in a room or space without adult supervision. The lunch area is intended for lunch times, teacher meetings, or classes only.

\_\_\_\_\_ Study Hall and lab times and locations are listed on the schedule. There is also an open-area study hall Monday-Thursday, 9:00-4:00. Students are expected to work quietly on schoolwork only. If necessary, students will be reminded to put away phones, and to leave the area if they are being disruptive. There is no study hall on Fridays, so students will need to attend Math Lab or get picked up. If a student is not in a designated area or has no work to complete during breaks, parents will be called to pick up their student.
