

The 8th graders receive a college presentation to help plan for high school, tour the campus and interactive classes also taught by faculty. Students will be on campus.





College & Career Information from Jen Burtram:

SENIORS!!

Don't forget about the FREE application for student aid. <u>www.fafsa.ed.gov</u>. I can help you if you bring in your Social Security Number, and your parent's tax return from 2016.

The whole process takes about 25 minutes if you have all your info.

I'm already getting the Cal Grant scholarship results and I see a LOT of eligible students who are eligible for up to \$12,630 at a University of California campus, up to \$5,742 at a California State University campus, up to \$9,084 at independent colleges, or \$1,672 at a two- or four-year college in addition to their Financial Award from the FAFSA.

The California Student Aid Commission thought a visual would help people see how many of our students are completing the FAFSA. There is a leaderboard which makes me feel a little competitive...but really, these numbers 'theoretically' show how many students of ours are even considering post-secondary options after high school. <u>https://webutil.csac.ca.gov/Dashboard/</u>

(If you type in Alder Grove, you can see how many students have completed their FAFSA! Let's work together to get these numbers up!)


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
