Thank you to all of the students who participated in CAASPP (Smarter Balanced) testing. We appreciate the time and effort you put in to help our school as we work to improve our math and language arts scores. The State of California has increased its focus on improvement in these areas, and if the amount of students who participated in our Interimpalooza test practice events is any indication, we are bound to see some growth! As you might imagine, organizing testing sessions for over 300 students is a HUGE task. A special thank you to Stefani and Brett, who coordinated the tests as a team and ran things with grace and a sense of humor. A big thanks to all of our CTs who worked so hard to schedule students and administer tests and office staff who helped out when needed. We couldn't have done it without you!

We will continue to order and stock our resource library with K-8 Common Core math and English/language arts curriculum for the 2018-2019 school year. These options are excellent for families interested in utilizing Common Core curriculum, will help familiarize students with assessment-aligned materials, and will come at NO COST to your student's account. Students Need These Immunizations to Start 7th Grade:

<u>Tetanus</u>, <u>Diphtheria</u>, <u>Pertussis</u> (Tdap) —1 dose (Whooping cough booster usually given at ages 11 and up)

<u>Measles</u>-containing vaccine (MMR) — 2 doses (Usually given at 12 months of age and 4-6 years of age)

This <u>school immunization law</u> affects all students in public and private schools. Parents must show their child's Immunization Record as proof of immunization.

Additional school immunization requirements for 7th graders typically apply to students who: Had a valid <u>personal beliefs exemption</u> filed before 2016 upon entry between TK/Kindergarten and 6th grade, or are new admissions, including from out-of-state; applies to all grades.






Students who are 16 or 17 years old can pre-register to vote!
