Hello Alder Grove Families,

If you're new to AGCS, welcome! If you are returning, welcome back! I hope you had a summer that included at least some rest and rejuvenation.

As of this writing, we just completed teacher in-service trainings and are collectively excited about the new school year! It's my sincere hope that we can support you and your student(s) in achieving academic excellence in our unique school model.

Here are some items we are looking forward to sharing with you for the new year:

Synchronous Instruction/Supports: Our CTs (credentialed teachers) will continue to offer opportunities for daily live instruction to TK-3 grade students, daily live interaction to 4-8 grade students, and weekly live instruction to 4-12 grade students. Talk to your CT about scheduling, and for more information about additional academic supports like tutoring, labs, support classes, online programs, etc.

Mental Health Workbooks: We realize that the last few years have been rough, and are offering free (not out of student budget) mental health and wellness workbooks to late elementary to high school students. Come see our display in the waiting area, and/or talk to your CT about ordering.

Staff Changes: I would like to welcome new staff members: New Education Specialist (SPED) Cary, Community School Coordinator Shana, and School Psychologist intern Monica. I would also like to welcome Secondary Support Specialists Jay and Sarah as well as our new Principal/Director of operations Stefani, to their new positions. We've also updated Jen's title to Director of Secondary Programs. Thank you to the wonderful employees who retired or resigned at the end of last year: Sandy and Rebecca (Teachers), and Becca (Purchasing and Receiving Specialist). We will miss you all.

New Transportation for CTE: Jen (Director of Secondary Programs) applied for a Strong Workforce grant for transportation and we received it late last year. 
### VISIT OUR NEW WEBSITE
