

Academic Success Policy

All students will be required to document on curriculum form that curriculum, supplies, etc. for each core class have been acquired before funds are spent on electives. Core classes are defined in our school as language arts, mathematics, social studies and science.

All students shall show that they are making individual progress on core areas each year before funds are spent on electives. In the case a student is not making progress in core areas as determined by the CT or scores on internal assessments, or a student scores below basic or far below basic on the STAR test, a meeting will be held with the teacher, parent and director early in the school year to determine the best method for addressing the academic areas of concern. These methods shall include tutoring sessions, additional core or supplemental curriculum suggested by the school, small group instruction on CD or on line remediation programs. These costs will come from the student's allocated funds.
